Day 1. Sep 26 - Las Vegas

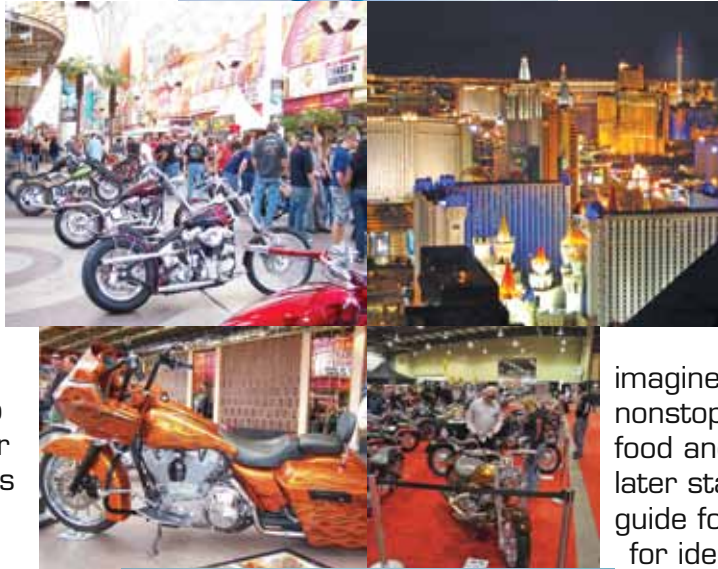


Day 4. Sep 29 - Las Vegas Bikefest

For those interested, there's a 'Poker Run' today. To enter, register at 7.30 am and be in line by 9 am. Join in for a scenic Las Vegas ride with a chance to win a cash prize if you have the best hand.

Day 6. Oct 01 - Las Vegas - Prescott

This morning we head to Prescott. Located in the central mountains of the state surrounded by large stands of ponderosa pine, Prescott was Arizona's first territorial capital. Today it boasts almost 800 historic buildings with many examples of Victorian architecture.



Canyon overwhelms the senses through its immense size and the grandeur of the landscape is truly spectacular. You'll have plenty of time to stop for fantastic photos. Later, we'll leave the National Park and head to Kingman for our overnight stay. You may like to visit the historic Route 66 Museum here.

Day 7. Oct 02 - Prescott - Sedona

Heading northeast today we'll ride through 'red rock' country on our way to Sedona. This picturesque town is surrounded by red-rock monoliths and at the north end of town is the stunning Oak Creek Canyon, a breathtaking chasm featuring an equally spectacular road.



Day 10. Oct 05 - Kingman - Las Vegas

On our return journey, we'll stop in the eccentric town of Oatman, where wild donkeys roam the streets, then ride through Lake Mead National Recreational Area on our way to Las Vegas where we return our bikes.



Day 8. Oct 03 - Sedona - Grand Canyon

Continuing north, we'll pass through Flagstaff on our way to our overnight stop in Tusayan which is at the entrance to the Grand Canyon National Park.



Day 11. Oct 06 - Tour ends Las Vegas

Your tour ends this morning after checkout from the hotel. Perhaps extend your stay in Las Vegas or travel to other parts of the USA.

Deposit

An non-refundable deposit of A\$400 per person is required within 14 days of reservation to secure your place on this tour.

Final Payment

Because events can 'sell out' quickly, we are required to advise passenger details well in advance so as to secure the arrangements from hotels, tour operators, coach companies, airlines and event ticket sales offices. We seek your understanding and co operation in this matter and advise full payment is due 90 days prior to departure. Bookings received after this date will require payment in full within 7 days.

Payment by credit card

A fee will be charged on the value of the amount being charged to your credit card and will be added to the amount being paid. Fees: Mastercard & Visa Card 2%; Diners Club & American Express 4%

Cancellation after full payment will incur the following fees; Days prior to departure:

Up to 46 days: 25%; 45-31 days: 50%; 30-0 days: 100% of tour price.

Single travellers

We are unable to 'pair up' solo passengers who seek to share a room. However if we know that another solo passenger of the same gender is interested in sharing, we offer to put you in touch with each other prior to departure. If both agree to twin share accommodation we require written confirmation of that agreement from both parties. If you wish to pursue this offer please mention it to your travel agent so you can be placed on a list at the time of paying deposit. If an opportunity does not arise then 'Price C' will apply.

Travel Insurance

It is a requirement that all passengers participating in these tours effect appropriate travel insurance at the time of booking, please ask us for information. Your travel insurance policy must include coverage for cancellation fee. Proof of insurance cover is required to be submitted to Elite Special Event Tours thirty (30) days prior to departure.
