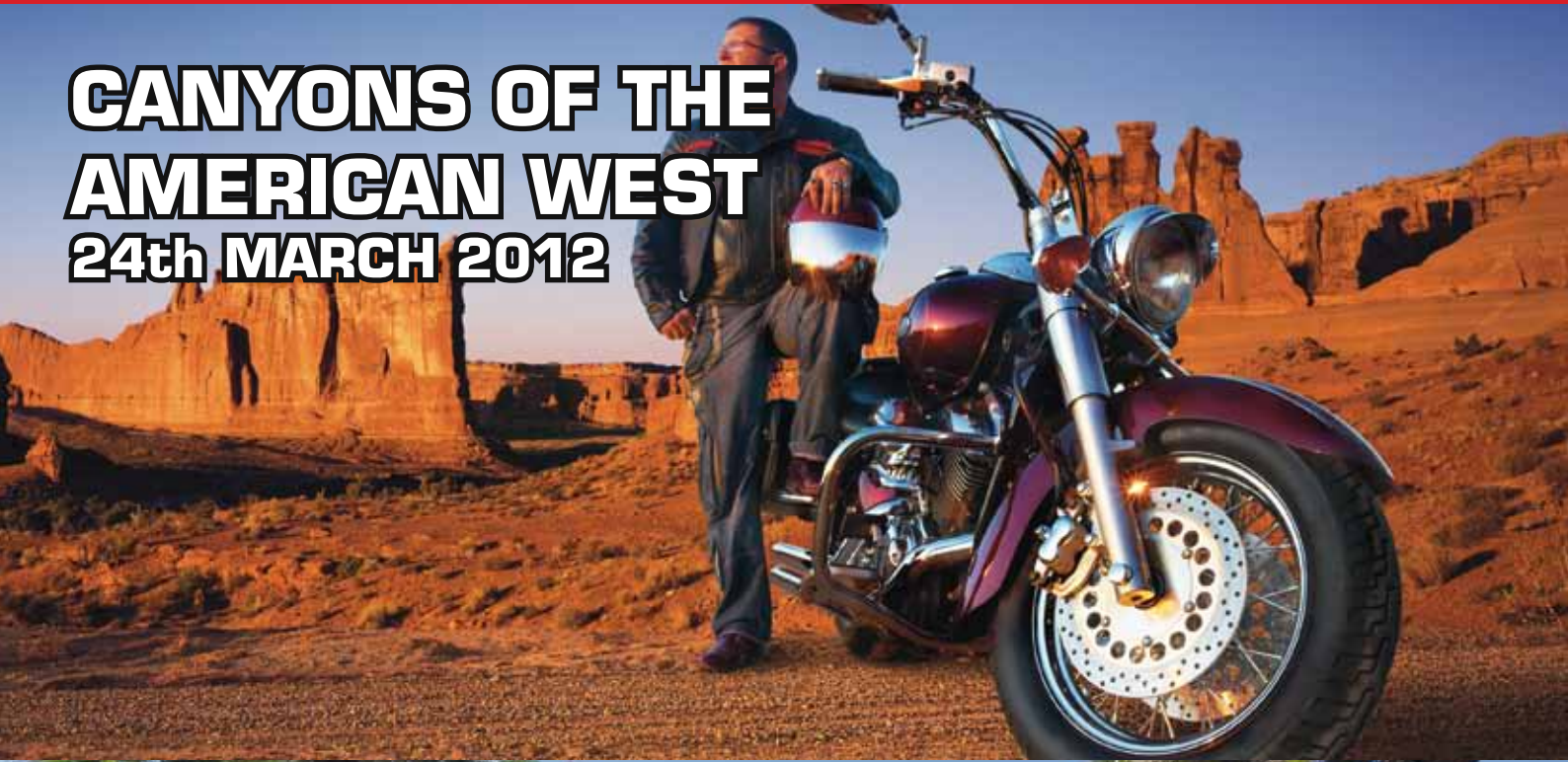

## CANYONS OF



From the excitement and bright lights of Las Vegas, ride through the spectacular desert scenery of Prescott and Sedona's Red Rock Canyons, as well as visiting the stunning Oak Creek Canyon then go on over some of America's best biker roads toward the Grand Canyon. This spectacular Canyon defies description, then ride on through the Arizona section of Route 66, through Kingman and the quaint old western mining town of Oatman. This town has hardly changed since the 1800's and is a popular stop for bikers travelling through this part of Arizona.

### Day 1. March 24 - Las Vegas

After arriving in Las Vegas today, check into our tour hotel. This evening meet your fellow Ulysses Club members for a welcome dinner to review maps and discuss the days ahead.

### Day 2. Mar 25 - Las Vegas

Today our transfer vehicle will take us to collect our bikes, followed by an orientation ride around the city. Perhaps cruise down 'the Strip' and drop into the Harley-Davidson cafe. Or visit the huge Arlen Ness dealership to swap motorcycle stories and see some great custom fabrications.



### Day 3. Mar 26 - Las Vegas at leisure

A day to spend at your own pace. Relax and enjoy the hotel facilities; maybe hit the tables in the casinos or do some shopping. Or perhaps you may prefer to take a ride out to Hoover Dam. The choice is yours.

## DAYTONA



Daytona has positioned itself as the automotive and bike capital of the USA. Bikers flock twice a year to attend two of the biggest rallies in America. Now you can combine the best of the Biketoberfest Rally with a spectacular ride commencing in New Orleans and following the picturesque coastline of the Gulf of Mexico. Ride from the Mississippi to the Atlantic Ocean, then kick back and explore this famous motor town. Take part in the many local rides of the area, and don't forget a visit to Cape Kennedy.

### Day 1. Oct 11 - New Orleans

Check into the New Orleans tour hotel today. There are no events planned this evening so you have time to relax.

### Day 2. Oct 12 - New Orleans

Today we head to our bike supplier. Here we'll pick out our bikes, sort out any gear you might need and complete our rental contracts. Tonight, we'll meet for our welcome dinner and to discuss the logistics of the days ahead.

### Day 3. Oct 13 New Orleans at leisure

There's plenty to see and do here in 'The Big Easy', with time for you to explore at your own pace. Discover the unique French Quarter or perhaps take an optional excursion on an airboat out on the bayou. (additional cost).



# THE AMERICAN WEST



## Day 4. Mar 27 - Las Vegas - Prescott

This morning we head to the town of Prescott. Located in the central mountains, surrounded by large stands of ponderosa pine, it was Arizona's first territorial capital.

Today it boasts over 800 historic buildings with many fine examples of Victorian architecture.

## Day 5. Mar 28 - Prescott - Sedona

Heading northeast today we'll ride through 'red rock' country on our way to Sedona. This picturesque city is surrounded by red-rock monoliths and at the north end of town is the stunning Oak Creek Canyon, a breathtaking chasm featuring an equally spectacular road.



## Day 6. Mar 29 - Sedona - Grand Canyon

Continuing north, we'll pass through Flagstaff on our way to our overnight stop in Tusayan.

## Day 7. Mar 30 - Grand Canyon - Kingman

Today we follow the south rim of the Grand Canyon with stops at various lookouts en route. A powerful and inspiring landscape, the Grand Canyon overwhelms the senses through its immense size and the grandeur of the landscape is truly spectacular. We stay tonight in Kingman, where you may like to visit the historic Route 66 Museum.



## Day 8. Mar 31 - Kingman - Oatman - Las Vegas

On our return journey, we'll stop to see wild burros in the street in the eccentric town of Oatman then ride through Lake Mead National Recreational Area on our way back to Las Vegas where we return our bikes.



## Day 9. Apr 01 - Depart Las Vegas

Your tour ends this morning after checkout from the hotel. Perhaps extend your stay in Las Vegas or travel to other parts of the USA. We can help with your bookings for any extra arrangements.

# BIKETOBERFEST RALLY



## Day 4. Oct 14 - New Orleans - Mobile

We head east today, following the sandy shore of the Gulf of Mexico along the coast road from Louisiana to Alabama. First we cross the Lake Pontchartrain Causeway, then to the coast and through Biloxi before heading north along Mobile Bay to Mobile. For those interested there's a great aircraft and Navy museum here.

## Day 5. Oct 15 - Mobile - Fort Walton Beach

Today we cross the Mobile causeway as we continue eastward. We'll follow the picturesque Gulf coast through Pensacola and along the Barrier Islands to Fort Walton Beach.



## Day 6. Oct 16 - Fort Walton Beach - Perry

Continuing along the coastline to Appalachicola, we then head away from the coast to Perry where we will spend this evening in preparation of our ride the next day to Daytona.

## Day 7. Oct 17 - Perry - Daytona Beach

Our ride this morning takes us to Ocala then east to the Atlantic coast, arriving in Daytona mid-afternoon where we check into our hotel which will be home for the next 5 nights.



## Days 8 - 10

### Oct 18-20 - Biketoberfest Activities

Engage in the spectacular Daytona Biketoberfest events: meet with fellow bikers in an air of camaraderie, visit booths and stalls offering all manner of bike merchandise and take part in many of the rides through nearby trails.



## Day 11. Oct 21 - Daytona - Optional ride to Cape Canaveral - Kennedy Space Center

Today do your own thing, or take the option of a visit to Kennedy Space Center (*additional cost*). It's a short ride to Cape Canaveral for the Space Center Tour which takes you to the International Space Station Center, LC 39 Observation Gantry and the Apollo/Saturn V Center. We return to Daytona for an evening at leisure.



## Day 12. Oct 22 - Daytona - Orlando

We bid farewell to Daytona and the many friends we've made as we head to Orlando to return our bikes and it's here our tour ends. You may like to stay on in the area or continue your vacation in another part of the US. We'll be happy to assist you with your arrangements.

**Important Information and Booking Conditions Deposit**

An non-refundable deposit of A\$400 per person is required within 14 days of reservation to secure your place on this tour.

**Final Payment**

Because events can 'sell out' quickly, we are required to advise passenger details well in advance so as to secure the arrangements from hotels, tour operators, coach companies, airlines and event ticket sales offices. We seek your understanding and co operation in this matter and advise full payment is due 90 days prior to departure. Bookings received after this date will require payment in full within 7 days.

**Payment by credit card**

A fee will be charged on the value of the amount being charged to your credit card and will be added to the amount being paid. Fees: Mastercard & Visa Card 2%; Diners Club & American Express 4%

**Cancellation** after full payment will incur the following fees; Days prior to departure:

Up to 46 days: 25%; 45-31 days: 50%; 30-0 days: 100% of tour price.

**Single travellers**

We are unable to 'pair up' solo passengers who seek to share a room. However if we know that another solo passenger of the same gender is interested in sharing, we offer to put you in touch with each other prior to departure. If both agree to twin share accommodation we require written confirmation of that agreement from both parties. If you wish to pursue this offer please mention it to your travel agent so you can be placed on a list at the time of paying deposit. If an opportunity does not arise then Price 'C' will apply.

**Travel Insurance**

It is a requirement that all passengers participating in these tours effect appropriate travel insurance at the time of booking, please ask us for information. Your travel insurance policy must include coverage for cancellation fee. Proof of insurance cover is required to be submitted to Elite Special Event Tours at least thirty (30) days prior to departure.

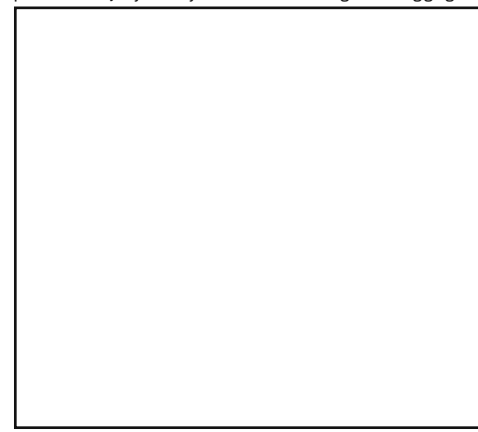
**Minimum group size**
